Application of Joseph E. Marenger No. 14443

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of second degree murder.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 4th day of September A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Mc Cree presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to serve an indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Joseph Eli Marenger
I was convicted under the name of Joseph Eli Marenger

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: R. W. Seyboldt and
Noel E. White

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except that which
I am serving time for at this time.
