Gentlemen:

In re Application of Fred Hopkins for
Termination of sentence.

Judgment in this case was imposed September 8, 1924, and upon a plea of Hopkins of guilty to an information charging him with an Assault with Intent to commit bodily harm, made on June 22nd, 1924.

Originally an information was filed charging this man with an assault with a deadly weapon with intent to commit murder. On recommendation of the District Attorney, that charge was dismissed and the charge upon which the present conviction was had, substituted in lieu thereof.

While this sentence was imposed on the 8th of September, 1924, nevertheless the man had been in prison from July 22nd, being unable to give bail when bound over by the committing magistrate.

I am sending you herewith a history of the case, and make no recommendation in the matter.
