Application of Glen H. Learned

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Embezzlement & Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 16th day of September
A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake,
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Ephraim Hansen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Glen H. Learned

I was convicted under the name of Glen H. Learned

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except this one.

I respectfully petition your Honorable Board for a termination
of sentence, rather than a parole, for the reason that I may
obtain employment outside the State of Utah.
