

APPLICATION OF ROY SHERRILL FOR A RE-HEARING

I, Roy E. Sherrill, being first duly sworn, on oath deposes and says that he is confined in the Utah State Prison by virtue of a Commitment from the Third Judicial District, County of Salt Lake, on a charge of Forgery, having been received April 10th, 1923.

That his application for Termination of sentence was considered and denied by the Board of Pardons at their meeting held August 22nd, 1925.

That he was paroled December 20th, 1924, and was returned February 25th, 1925. That certain charges were made to the Board of Pardons concerning his return for Violation of Parole which were not founded on facts and can not be substantiated.

That at the August meeting of the Board it was not possible for his mother to be present, as she was out of the state and he had made no solicitation for anyone to be present at the August meeting.

That his Mother has now returned from Los Angeles and will appear before the Board in his half and that she desires to take him to California with her when she returns there in the very immediate future.

That affiant pleads now for his release at this time in order that he may accompany his Mother to California, and assures the Board that with new associates and surroundings he will make good.
