

RE The State v Ira E Brown

This defendant entered a plea of guilty to the charge of Accessory to the commission of the crime of Robbery, and then Judge Kimball imposed the maximum penalty of one year in the Weber County jail. The actual robbery was committed by Howard Lindsley and Guy Roland, who held up the proprietor of a gas station while Brown was across the street in a garage. Later some of the property was found in Brown's garage. Lindsley and Roland were committed to the Penitentiary on their pleas of guilty to Robbery, and Mr. Lindsley has since been paroled or has had his sentence terminated.

I recommend that at the June 20th meeting of the Board Brown be paroled to his father, who is a prominent business man of Ogden.
