Gentlemen:-

I have been informed that Compton R. Hubbard an inmate of the State Prison has or will file an application to your Honorable Board for termination of sentence. Mr. Hubbard on or about the 4th day of September, 1923 entered a plea of grand larceny before Judge M. L. Ritchie in the Third Judicial District Court of Salt Lake County, Utah. At that time as Assistant District Attorney I recommended the minimum of one year and as I have been informed Judge Ritchie followed my recommendation.

Mr. Hubbard entered a plea of guilty in his case and saved the State considerable expense for the reason that the individual who owned the property which was stolen was residing at that time in Boston, Massachusetts, if my memory serves me correctly. He had up to the time of being sentenced served approximately 5 months in the County Jail. In view of all these facts I would recommend that his application be granted.
