You will please pardon the liberty I am taking in writing this letter, but as I am a stranger here in this state with out friends to explain my case I take this means of informing the Hon Board of Pardons of the peculiarities of my case.

In my application blank for parole I left the part which requires previous convictions blank, because it would appear on the surface that I was a hardened criminal, with out an explanation.

I was paroled from the Nevada State prison, after serving (20) twenty month of a two to (14) fourteen year sentence, to the salt lake authorities brought back, awaited trial for six months here in the county jail and finally pled guilty to grand larceny, and sentenced to from one to ten years with a recommendation of one year, a total of
