and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Adultery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of July
A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in the Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Emerson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an Indeterminate Term of from
Two to six years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison for a period
three months and have since October
1923 been in parole to Mr. A. E. Harney

Fourth-- Honorable Fess Hutchinson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Eddie Terry
I was convicted under the name of Eddie Terry
