Concerning my Plea for a Release from the Wtah State Prison. I kindly ask you to investigate the following facts I was returning home from work. When a Lady friend of mine called me to her Room to raise a window I talked to her not more than five minutes. When the officers arrested me. at trial some officers testified that Lady was married Counsel Proving fact Not so.

These facts can Grant me a Pardon or Termination of sentence I was arrested on the night of June 5-1923. I was convicted and sentenced to the State Prison on July 14-1923. I am now serving a term in the State Prison for an offense which I am Not Even Guilty of. I am working on the State Road at the present time. at Enter Prise Wtah. Any information you wish to obtain concerning my conduct or Behaviour you may Refer to Mr John Gray the Guard.

A charge was switched on me. I am positively single. And I never have been married. in this particular case Neither Party is married I consider it a Gross injustice to be treated so. Therefore I kindly ask you to consider these facts. and investigate the Evidence that have been given in my case. And I am sure you will see the injustice given me. I being my Mother's soul Support who is very old. and Needs me. So I Hope you will consider
