When a Lady friend of mine called me to her Room to Raise a Window I talked to her Not more than five minutes When the officers arrested me. At Trial some officers testified that Lady was married Counsel Proving fact or not so.

Charge was switched on me. I am Possitively Single. Am I Never Have Been married. In this Particular case Neither Party is married I consider it a Grave injustice to be treated so. Therefore I kindly ask you to consider these facts. And investigate the Evidence that Have Been given in my case. And I am sure you will see the injustice given me. I being my Mother's soul Support Who is Very old. And Needs me. So I hope you will consider

These facts and Grant me a Pardon or Termination of sentence I was arrested on the night of June 5-1923. I was convicted and sentenced to the State Prison on July 14-1923. I am now serving a term in the State Prison for an offence which I am Not Even Guilty of. I am Working on the State Road at the Present Time. at Enter Priso Utah. Any any information you wish to obtain concerning my conduct or Behaviour you may Refer to Mr John Brown the Sheriff.
