First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of August  
A. D. 1922, at Farmington County of Deer's  
and State of Utah, in 2nd District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to 1 to 10 years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E.E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is D.O. Southworth  
I was convicted under the name of D.O. Southworth

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: none

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except none
