Application of Stephen A. Fuller

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of indecent assault

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 21th day of May A. D. 1913, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable F. O. Loofbourow presiding

Third—I was sentenced to Ten years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable E. O. Leatherwood prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Stephen A. Fuller I was convicted under the name of Stephen A. Fuller

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except Indecent assault
