Application of Ray S. Morgan

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Burglary.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of July A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3<sup>rd</sup> District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Matthews presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Sentence and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rodgers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Ray Samuel Morgan I was convicted under the name of Ray Samuel Morgan

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except 2 Terms of Second Degree Burglary.
