Application of E.J. McCULLOUGH

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a TERMINATION,  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in THE UTAH STATE PRISON  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of AUTOMOBILE THEFT

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 12 day of AUGUST  
A. D. 1924, at BRIGHAM CITY UTAH County of BOX ELDER  
and State of Utah, in SECOND DISTRICT Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable MELVIN C. HARRIS presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to AN INDETERMINATE TERM OF THREE MONTHS  
TO TEN YEARS.  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the UTAH STATE PRISON

Fourth-- Honorable LEROY B. YOUNG prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is ELMER JAMES McCULLOUGH  
I was convicted under the name of E.J. McCULLOUGH

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: NONE

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except BREAKING & ENTERING  
INTO A WAY CAR (CABOOSE), IN THE STATE OF NEBRASKA.
