To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination Conditional and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 12 day of August A. D. 1924, at Brigham City County of Box Elder and State of Utah, in Melvin C. Harris Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable 1st District presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Three months to ten years an indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable E. B. Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Elmer James McCullough I was convicted under the name of E. J. McCullough.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Yes I was convicted of breaking and entering in the State of Nebraska and was confined in the State institution at Lincoln Neb. for a period of seventeen months.
