Application of Jess Davis.

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Third degree burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of July A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Matthewson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.
