Application of Edward Romberg

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon or termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First -- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the penitentiary under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Polygamy

Second -- I was convicted and sentenced on the 18th day of April A. D. 1925, at Farmington County of Davis and State of Utah, in the district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. N. Kimball presiding.

Third -- I was sentenced to the State penitentiary for a term of not less than one day and not more than five years and thereafter was imprisoned in the state penitentiary

Fourth -- Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth -- My true name in full is Edward Romberg I was convicted under the name of Edward Romberg

Sixth -- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none

Seventh -- I have never been convicted of any offense except the above
