Application of George Manousos

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of attempt to commit murder

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the day of September A. D. 1924, at Price County of Carbon and State of Utah, in Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christenson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to indeterminate sentence and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison on the 19th day of September, 1924, and paroled March 26, 1925 to T. J. Parmelee of Winters Quarters, Utah.

Fourth-- Honorable W. B. Dalton prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is George Manousos I was convicted under the name of George Manousos
