First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of grand larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the fifth day of Feb.
A. D. 1925, at Logan County of Cache
and State of Utah, in first District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Melvin C. Harris presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from one to ten
years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Leroy B. Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Andres Gonzales
I was convicted under the name of Andres Gonzales

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Juan Perez

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Grand larceny
