I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in County jail of Weber County, under conviction and a sentence on a charge of having liquor in possession

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 20th day of July A. D. 1925, at Ogden, County of Weber and State of Utah, in the District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George J. Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Sixty days in the county jail of Weber County, Utah, and thereafter was imprisoned in the County jail.

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Ray Shurtliff I was convicted under the name of Ray Shurtliff

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the one discussed herein
