Application of Brigham Lyon

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Adultery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 6th day of September
A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Wm. M. McCrea presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an Indeterminate Term in the Utah
State Prison
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable W. R. Hutchinson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Brigham Lyon
I was convicted under the name of Brigham Lyon

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except once in Utah State
Prison about twenty years ago.
