SECOND COUNT.

That the said defendants did commit the further crime of forgery as follows, to-wit:

That the said Chris Hammer and Pete Moe on the 11th day of November, 1923, at Tooele County, State of Utah, wilfully, unlawfully, falsely, feloniously and knowing the same to be false, counterfeited and intended to prejudice, damage and defraud Tri State Mercantile Company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Utah, did utter, publish and pass as genuine and true to and upon the aforesaid Tri State Mercantile Company, a corporation, of the State of Utah, a certain false, forged and counterfeited writing on paper preporting to be a bank check the tenor whereof is as follows, to-wit:
