THE COURT: What is your plea to this information, Mr. Hammer, guilty or not guilty?

DEFENDANT HAMMER: Guilty.

THE COURT: Mr. Moe, what is your plea to this information?

THE COURT: The Court advises you gentlemen that you can take time for the passing of sentence or you can waive time and receive sentence at this time. What do you wish to do, Mr. Hammer?

DEFENDANT HAMMER: I don't understand.

THE COURT: You can have the sentence of the court imposed now or you can take time, but not to exceed twenty-four hours.

DEFENDANT HAMMER: I don't understand.

THE COURT: After you plead guilty to the offense charged in the information, it is necessary for the Court to impose sentence.

DEFENDANT HAMMER: Yes.

THE COURT: You can have your sentence now.

DEFENDANT HAMMER: I will take it now.

THE COURT: You will take it now?

DEFENDANT HAMMER: Yes.
