Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of December A. D. 1923, at Tooele County of Tooele and State of Utah, in 3rd District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wight presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Chris Hammer I was convicted under the name of Chris Hammer

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Pete Moe

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
