Application of William D. Harrison

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 18 day of October A. D. 1924, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to 1-20 years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is William Henry Harrison

I was convicted under the name of " " "

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Mr. Joseph Kirie
