Application of Thomas Davis

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 28th day of Oct., A. D. 1924, at Provo County of Utah and State of Utah, in Fourth District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable E. Hansen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to 5 years to life

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State prison

Fourth-- Honorable County Attorney Hansen prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Thomas M. Davis I was convicted under the name of Thomas Davis

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Albert H. Bergerson

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except this one.
