I, Albert H. Bergeson, being first duly sworn, on oath, deposes and says:

That I am serving an Indeterminate term in the Utah State Prison, having been committed from the city of Provo, County of Utah, on the 22nd day of September, 1924, by virtue of my plea of guilty to a charge of Highway Robbery.

That on October 20th, 1924, Thomas Davis, also now serving here, was convicted by a jury in the same city and county of complicity in the charge for which I plead guilty.

That there two other men implicated in this Robbery with me, neither of whom have ever been apprehended.

That Thomas Davis had no knowledge of this crime, and was not implicated in any way.

I make this statement solely for the reason that I do not wish to see an innocent man punished for a crime of which he is entirely innocent. I have been promised nothing whatever for this statement, and it is made of my own free will, and with a desire to see the ends of justice served.
