First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Auto theft

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 26th day of January
A. D. 1926, at Salt Lake city, County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge W. S. Marks presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to serve six months to three years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State prison

Fourth-- Honorable Samuel Clawson prosecuted the case.
