Application of Benjamin Varley

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Salt Lake County jail
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Petit Larceny

Second-- I was ^{plead guilty} convicted and sentenced on the 5th day of January
A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Morris L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to a term of six months

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Salt Lake County jail

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Benjamin Varley
