To the Honorable Board of Pardon of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in U. P. P. under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of Oct. A. D. 1921, at Salt Lake City County of P. & S. and State of Utah, in 3<sup>rd</sup> Judicial Dist. Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge J. D. Wright presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Term and thereafter was imprisoned in the U. P. P.

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Lester E. White

I was convicted under the name of Lester E. White

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Jos. Alexander, Fred Templeton, Fred Williams D. Hartzel

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except as above
