Application of Lester E. White.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison, under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 20th day of Oct. A. D. 1921, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Hon. L. B. Wight, presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to from five years to life and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable Mr. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Lester E. White. I was convicted under the name of Lester E. White.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: James Alexander, Fred Williams, and Fred Templeton.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except as above.
