I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in U. P. P. under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 21st day of Oct. A. D. 1921, at Salt Lake City County of P. L. and State of Utah, in 3rd Judicial Dist. Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge L. D. Wright presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Term and thereafter was imprisoned in the U. P. P.

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Lester E. White I was convicted under the name of Lester E. White

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Geo. Alexander, Fred Puppington, Fred Williams, D. Hartzel

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except as above
