First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Highway Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 20th day of October A. D. 1921, at Salt Lake City County of 3rd Dist. Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wright presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable E. W. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Lester E. White
