First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Possession of Licker.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 8 day of September
A. D. 1924, at Brigham City County of Box Elder
and State of Utah, in Mr. Judge Harris Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Mr. Judge Harris presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to 3 months, 2 years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Marabel Gallie prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Broadie Young Westmoreland
I was convicted under the name of Broadie Young Westmoreland
