On Feb. 2, 1925, the alien Lino Lopez was ordered deported to Mexico, such deportation to be at such time as he is released from your prison.

and should not be confused with another inmate, likewise under order of deportation, whose real name is Estanislao Macias, but who is in prison under the name of Raymond Martinez, #4325.

Will you please have this alien's record marked to show that we are to be notified one month in advance of his contemplated release, in order that we may make arrangements to deport him when he is released from prison?

This alien is serving 5 years to life commencing Dec. 19, 1923.
