Application of Pete Robert Johnson

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary, 3rd Degree

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Fourth day of October  
A. D. 1913, at Brigham City County of Box Elder  
and State of Utah, in First Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Hon. Melvin C. Harris presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Sentence

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Leroy B. Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Pete Robert Johnson  
I was convicted under the name of Pete Robert Johnson

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: Joseph Ormond

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Robbery  
Burglary
