to the Honorable State Board of Pardons:

Gentlemen:-

I was foreman of the jury in the case of The State of Utah vs Joseph Ormona and Pete Robert Johnson.

In that case on the first ballot the jurors stood seven for "Not guilty" and one for "guilty".

The one juror held out to make an example against these defendants but finally all voted "guilty" with a recommendation as follows:

"We recommend all the leniency the Court can grant."

I understand that our District Judge has recommended a Pardon for these two men, and I understand that the District Attorney has recommended a pardon.

I, as foreman, of the trial jury join with the rest and respectfully ask that a pardon be granted to these defendants.
