Honorable Sir:-

May I not be pardoned for infringing on your valuable time, but I am very desirous of bringing my case to your attention, and feel that you will agree with me in the opinion that I have been amply punished for the offence that I am now serving time for.

I have been here six months but previous to coming here I was some fourteen months awaiting trial the outcome of which was a disagreement, and then after conviction on the second trial I did two months in the county jail.

Inasmuch that nearly all cases of similar character are county jail sentences and that I was subject to continual persecution by my consul, who had a personal grudge against me I feel that I have paid dearly for the offence, and that if given an opportunity I can again take my place as a useful citizen.
