

time with them in the room and sitting and reclining upon the bed. This defendant has served a term in the Utah State Prison for Murder, but was pardoned. The evidence in the case in which he was convicted of the crime of pandering was strong.

The Court recommends that the defendant be incarcerated in the State Prison of the State of Utah for a period of three years, provided, of course, that his conduct, while in the State Prison, shall be proper and commendable.
