Application of Nellie Trujillo #4510

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Murder 2nd Degree

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of December,  
A. D. 1924, at Provo, Utah County of Duchesne  
and State of Utah, in the Fourth Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Elias Hansen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable M. B. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Nellie Trujillo  
I was convicted under the name of Nellie Trujillo

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: Elnora Van, Ernest Trujillo and Harris Murray.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
