Application of Nellie Trujillo No. 45-10

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd Degree Murder

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of December
A. D. 1924, at Vernal County of Uintah
and State of Utah, in Uintah Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Harrison presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 10 Years to Life

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable M B Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Mrs L G Kramer

I was convicted under the name of Miss Nellie Ellenore Trujillo

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except
