First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in have been on parole April 1927 under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Murder

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 26^o day of Sept 1924 A. D. at Vernal Utah County of Wasatch and State of Utah, in Vernal Utah Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable _____ presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Term years to life in the Utah State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable County Attorney M. B. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Mrs Nellie Kramer I was convicted under the name of Miss Nellie Trujillo

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Ernest Trujillo Harris Murray & Elmore Van

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Braking my parole by getting married was returned to prison for 6 months. I've been on parole two years this April three years with the exceptions of 6 months.
