Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Fifth day of July
A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Ephraim Hanson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One to Ten years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable W. R. Hutchinson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is J. P. Brown
I was convicted under the name of Jack Dillon

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
