Application of George B. Morrison

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a re-hearing of my petition for a pardon and termination of sentence, heretofore considered on Feb. 20, 1926 and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Salt Lake County Jail under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Possession of intoxicating Liquor

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 3rd day of October A. D. 1925, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Salt Lake City Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Gaylen S. Young presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to four months in the Salt Lake County Jail, sixty days to be suspended for your good behavior, a part of the condition of good behavior being the payment of fines of \$598.00 before the expiration of sixty days. and thereafter was imprisoned in the

Salt Lake County Jail on the 7th day of December, 1925.


