Application of Frank Brancali

On the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Rape

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of Nov.  
A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in 3rd Judicial Dist Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge L. M. Ritch presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to An indeterminate sentence  
from 1 to 10 years.  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison  
on the 13th day of Nov. 1923.

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rodgers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Frank Brancali  
I was convicted under the name of Frank Brancali

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: none

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except this.  
And Honorable Board I am not guilty of  
Rape as charged - for this woman was 25 yrs  
of age - and I paid her for services as any  
women charges that is in restricted district  
And on record as evidence - her own admission that  
I paid her 2 dollars per service - 9 different times making  
a total of 18 dollars -
