and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary, 2nd Degree

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of December
A. D. 1923, at Los Angeles County of Los Angeles
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wright presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to An indeterminate term
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Selfino Lopez
I was convicted under the name of Selfino Lopez
