First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 22 day of January  
A. D. 1925, at Fillmore County of Millard  
and State of Utah, in 5<sup>th</sup> District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable T. H. Burton presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to 1 to 20 years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Dudley C. Craft prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Scott Hustley Lantz  
I was convicted under the name of Scott Hustley Lantz

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Forgery
