Just a few words to tell you concerning my case. There are some points to my advantage which were not brought up at trial. I pleaded guilty and the state furnished me with counsel I ask him to put a plea for leniency but he never said a word and when the Judge ask me if I had any thing to say I said no expecting him to tell the Judge. A few minutes after I asked this check I went back and gave the money back and three days after the bank had me arrested. The Judge told me when I thought I had made a man of my self to go up before the board. I feel that if I am given a chance I will show him and the people I am a man this is my first conviction.
