Application of Joseph Ledoux

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 3rd Degree Burg.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 31st day of July A. D. 1924, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in 2nd district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Kimble presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable S. E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Joseph Ledoux I was convicted under the name of Same

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None
