First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 25 day of March  
A. D. 1925, at Price County of Carbon  
and State of Utah, in Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to indeterminate sentence of not  
less than one nor more than ten years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison of State of  
Utah on or about April 1-1925

Fourth-- Honorable F. W. Keller prosecuted the case.
